Partial History of the Family of Godfrey Family

Godfrey Wolds and his wife Charlotte both born near Nordhausen Germany in the year 1819, came to America as German immegrants in the year 1872. They stooped as or near Chicage Illinois where they had relatives until the year 1877 when they came to Kansas in a covered wagon and took up a Hossostead along Terkey Creek 10% miles Northwest of Yates Center Namsas. They lived in a log cabin until the year 1871 when a stone house was built. A stone in the gable of the house was still visible 100 years later with the letters G.W. 1871 carved on its face. Later with the help of some Bussian immegrants a sed house was built which served as the home of the family until 1884 when a large ten room frame house was built on the home site; Charlotte Weide died in 1871 and was first buried on a knoll on the bank of the creek. Later her remains were placed with those of her husband who died in 1898 in the Turkey breek censtary. The Epitahs on their tempstones is written in German.

Minnie (Mrs John Misban), Frederick and William. Charles Weide narried Minnie Oppermen who was also a German immigrant and since he was the oldest child in the family be and his wife lived on the home place. During his active life the operations of the farm were expanded until there were twalve bundred acres of farm, pasture and hay land. There were three large barns, numerous sheds, granaries and other buildings to provide the shelter and food storage for the large flocks of sheep, cattle herds and horses needed to create the economic unit of that day.
